Therefore, we expect all campers to behave accordingly and to cooperate with the camp leaders by following ALL camp rules, schedules, and other instructions.

CAMP RULES


1. Keep the cabins and other camp facilities in order and clean at all times
2. Public phones must be used Only in case of emergency with a counselor present.
3. Boys must not enter the rooms for girls. Girls must not enter the rooms for boys.
4. Use appropriate dress for each activity.
5. Whoever damages camp property will pay for the expenses incurred. Pastor and parents will be notified, and persons involved may be sent home.
6. Romantic expressions will not be allowed.
7. Do not take anything out of the dining hall.
8. Do attend **all** camp activities.
9. Do not be outside cabins between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am. Anyone who breaks this rule **WILL** be sent home. Parents will be notified and are responsible to pick up their child if this happens.
10. Visitors are discouraged. Anyone not registered must have prior permission from camp director to be on campus and will have to pay the \$180.00 registration fee plus \$10.00 late fee.
11. Do not leave the campgrounds unless authorized by the camp director.
12. In case of any medical emergency, notify the camp nurse and/or camp director.
13. **WEAR** name tag **ALL THE TIME**.
14. Campers **CANNOT** use his or her car during camp. Keys will be confiscated by the camp director at
